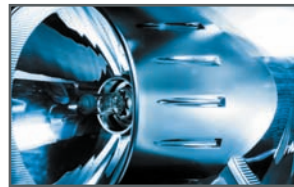

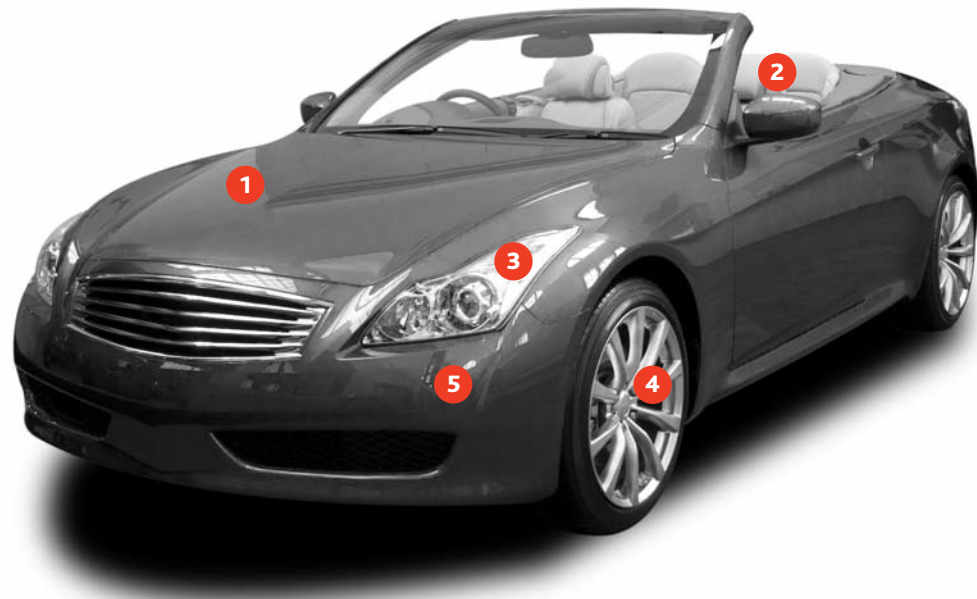

**Q: Will I need to reapply Williams F1 Ceramic Coat?**

**A: Williams F1 Ceramic Coat is GUARANTEED for 5 years. We will give you a written promise that you will not need to re wax, reapply or renew this product.**

**Q: How often should I clean or polish my car?**

**A: It sounds unlikely but you'll only need to WASH your car regularly with a mild soap (not dishwashing soap) and water solution. No polishing or waxing, think of the time you'll save!**

**Q: Can I put my car through a car wash?**

**A: Certainly, it may be the best way to keep your car clean. It will not effect the coating and you won't need to use an expensive program. A simple wash and dry cycle will do.**

**Q: Can I use any Car Shampoo on my car?**

**A: Yes, but we recommend using a leading car shampoo without wax content. Also check with your sales person, they may have Williams F1 Ceramic Coat car wash available here.**

**Q: How quickly should I remove bird droppings?**

**A: Although Williams F1 Ceramic Coat will protect against bird lime, it's always good practice to remove before it becomes baked on. Should it become solid, use a little mild soap to loosen before washing. Don't scrape it away as you will damage the coating and your paintwork.**

**Q: Should the worse thing happen and I damage my car, will I need to recoat with Williams F1 Ceramic Coat?**

**A: In the event of an accident we'll reapply on paintwork, alloy wheels, glass sunroofs, side windows and door mirror as part of your insurance claim.**
